Round the World Yacht Race Winning Skipper

In 2009, Brendan skippered a racing yacht in the ultimate long-distance challenge, The Clipper Round the World Yacht race – a 35,000-mile circumnavigation of the globe, contested by amateur crews in identical racing yachts.

Although Brendan was the youngest and least experienced skipper in the race, his team and he won it in convincing fashion. They didn't win because Brendan was the best sailor or strategist, but because he created the most engaged and empowered on-board culture, with a compelling vision, strong values and a continuous-improvement mindset.

In this session Brendan shares how to create a learning environment, where mistakes only happen once and how to effectively empower people when there's a constant pressure to perform (and "I'll just do it myself" syndrome kicks in).
